On an average 40 Village camps/ School Camps are held in each and every month of the year. ITS Dental College is collaborated with the National Service Scheme (NSS) in order to provide extended oral care to the poor and needy.

College has also adopted a village with a population of 3200. The residents of the village are provided free basic treatments and amenities. Special tobacco cessation unit has also been set up in Dept of public health dentistry. In celebrating occasions like world no tobacco day, the students get the opportunity to interact with patients from the nearby areas who take tobacco. Patients with oral cancer, who cannot afford advance treatments, are also treated at minimal possible cost. The college has also collaborated with Amar Ujala for "Aparajita - 100 million smiles", initiative which aims at empowering people especially women and ensuring that their rights are fulfilled and their dignity is maintained.

OUTREACH PROGRAMS

The overall well-being of the society is of utmost priority of our institution. Our institution firmly believes in providing professional services, or services of specific expertise, to a group of people who may not otherwise have access to them. I.T.S Dental college has always taken extra footsteps in conducting programs with best possible services for the holistic growth of the society. Our college has seven satellite centres rendering dental services in rural and urban areas. It is an attempt to provide dental care effectively to utilize the health services in its maximum range. Dental doctors skilled in clinical expertise along with interns are posted in all satellite to cater to the needs of community. Our students, interns and post graduates are posted on rotational basis at Dasna Jail to cater the treatment needs of the prisoners.

Many outreach activities are conducted in the form of micro-groups awareness camps and treatments, through 2 fully equipped mobile dental vans with seating capacity of 14 people. On an average 69 camps are held in each and every month of the year. The main aim of the camps is to create awareness regarding importance of oral health, to screen the patients for oral diseases and provide basics oral treatments at the camps site. Its Dental College is collaborated with the National Service Scheme (NSS) in order to provide extended oral care to poor and needy. A team of doctors along with post-graduate and under-graduate students with auxiliary staff render health care and undertake many activities like oral screening, oral health education and basic dental treatment like oral prophylaxis, tooth restorations and extractions. Patients with extensive treatments need from the college are also provided transportation to the college twice a week along with special discounted cards.

These programs are also conducted in various schools (School dental camps) of both public and private sectors are undertaken in rural as well as urban areas through 2 fully equipped mobile dental vans. Basic amenities like free oral health checkups, oral health instructions,

brushing techniques and oral hygiene instructions are given to the school children to promote good oral hygiene habits from an early age. There is a massive participation exhibited by the students on special events celebrated by ITS dental college such as children's week. Such events celebrated in college act as a awareness programs as well as motivation forums for the patient. The entire college gears up for and get divided into smaller group for organizing these events where maximum of there student can participate. It is extremely important in today's worlds to have an insight about the various things happening around us and while conducting these outreach program. Nukkad- nataks are also performed by the students for spreading awareness. The students of the college also see to have a positive learning curve from various such activities.

I.T.S dental college also adopted a village (Sultanpur) with a population of 3200. The residents of the village are provided free basic amenities like health consultations, basic free dental treatments, free general medicine and oral health kits. Free dental camps are organized once a month along health education pertaining of the objectives.

Awareness about oral cancer is also a key part of patient education at camp sites. Special tobacco cessation unit also been setup in department of public health dentistry to help patient leave deleterious habits and live a tobacco free life. Patients with oral cancer, who cannot afford advance treatments, are also treated in our department of oral and maxillofacial surgery at minimal possible cost.

Special attention is given to various events such as World Health Day, National Doctor's Day, National Dentists Day, World No Tobacco Day, International Women's Day, World Cancer Day, World Environment Day, World Oral Health Day etc. In celebrating occasions like world no tobacco day, the get the opportunity to interact with patients from the nearby areas who take tobacco and they motivate and educate these people regarding the ill

1.General

2.Objectives
